What does it take to work as a team?

- 1. Trust
 - "Timothy, guard what has been entrusted to your care." 1 Tim. 6:20 (NIV)
- 2. Emphatic
 - "Live in harmony with one another; be sympathetic." 1 Peter 3:8 (NIV)
- 3. Accommodating
 - "Be faithful, loving, and easy to get along with." 2 Tim. 2:22b (Contemporary English Version.)
- 4. Mission
 - "...be of the same mind, maintaining the same love, united in spirit, intent on one purpose." (New American Standard)

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- 1. Think of some groups you've been part of in which there was conflict. What led to that conflict?
- 2. Describe one real-life example of trust. Why is it so important?
- 3. In terms of empathy, some might argue, "I'm just not a mercy person." Is empathy required of us all or just from those of us who might have that spiritual gift? Explain.
- 4. How did Jesus accommodate for those in his group (the disciples)? What lessons can we learn from Him?
- 5. Think of a group experience—church group or not—that succeeded. Did you have a common mission? Think of a group experience that did not. Did you have a common mission? How important was that common focus?
